

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy explains how LanguageMaster.org ("we," "us," or "our") collects, uses, and protects your information when you use LanguageMaster.org (the "Service").

1. Information We Collect

We collect information you provide directly, such as your email address and password when you create an account. We also collect basic usage data (pages visited, features used, learning progress) to operate and improve the Service. Payment details for paid plans are handled entirely by PayPal — we never see or store your card or bank information.

2. How We Use Your Information

We use your information to: create and manage your account; process subscription payments; send account-related and service emails (such as password resets and, if you opt in, our weekly learning digest); track learning progress across devices; and improve the Service through aggregate, privacy-respecting analytics.

3. Analytics

We use Plausible Analytics, a privacy-focused analytics tool that does not use cookies and does not track individuals across websites. We may also use Google Tag Manager / Google Analytics to understand aggregate site usage.

4. Cookies

We use a small number of essential cookies to keep you logged in and to remember your preferences (such as which homepage variant you were shown). We do not use third-party advertising cookies.

5. Sharing of Information

We do not sell your personal information. We share information only with service providers necessary to operate the Service (such as PayPal for payment processing and our email delivery provider), and only to the extent needed to provide the Service.

6. Data Retention and Security

We retain your account information for as long as your account is active, and use industry-standard measures (including password hashing and encrypted connections) to protect it. No method of transmission or storage is 100% secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

7. Your Rights

You may access, correct, or delete your account information at any time from your account settings, or by contacting us. You may unsubscribe from marketing emails at any time using the link in those emails.

8. Children's Privacy

The Service is not directed at children under 16. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 16 without parental consent.

9. Changes to This Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. Continued use of the Service after changes take effect constitutes acceptance of the revised policy.
